A draft survey has been completed or the project so far but other than that it is still in the early phases to where adding acreage is still feasible.

The Board discussed Ms. Boyd's application and agreed that she seemed like a good prospect, but they wanted to ensure she could make the meeting times since she works as a teacher. Staff informed the Board they would reach out and forward her response.

- The Planning Board has been having discussions around short-term rentals (STRs) and Mr. Guie and Ms. Wells asked Staff to provide information around the policy. Ms. Zijp forwarded the Board an infographic that Ms. Gillian Phillips from the Planning Dept. provided. Ms. Phillips will also be coming to the May AAB meeting updating them on how the Planning Board votes on the policy during their upcoming meeting.

Announcements & Discussions

Mr. Duckett recently started a new position as the Western Region Direction with NC Extension that has increased his travel outside of the County. This has affected his ability to attend meetings as frequently as he used to be able to and he is planning to step down as Chair.
