The committee made the following funding recommendations for FY2024-2025:

- Splitting the available \$73,357 to partially fund the Buncombe County Youth Justice Clinical Program (BCYJCP) and Umoja+UNETE:
  - \$50,000 going to the BCYJCP
  - \$23,257 to Umoja
- To discontinue funding for Buncombe Structured Day for FY24-25.
- To reallocate the \$66,893 previously allocated to them by releasing a second RFP for the priority program types listed below:
  1. Comprehensive Clinical Assessments (CCAs) / Individual or Group Counseling / Substance Use Counseling Services
  2. Restorative Services / Restorative Justice
  3. Structured Day / Tutoring / Academic Enhancement / Mentoring
