Review and Action of Allocations Committee Recommendations: Angel Redmond, Allocations Chair The committee made the following funding recommendations for FY2024-2025:

- Splitting the available \$73,357 to partially fund the Buncombe County Youth Justice
 Clinical Program (BCYJCP) and Umoja+UNETE:
 - \$50,000 going to the BCYJCP
 - \$23,257 to Umoja
- o To discontinue funding for Buncombe Structured Day for FY24-25.
- To reallocate the \$66,893 previously allocated to them by releasing a second RFP for the priority program types listed below:
 - Comprehensive Clinical Assessments (CCAs) / Individual or Group Counseling / Substance Use Counseling Services
 - 2. Restorative Services / Restorative Justice
 - 3. Structured Day / Tutoring / Academic Enhancement / Mentoring
